## Working with Children Checks

- Queensland Government does not recognise working with children checks conducted outside of Queensland.
- If you are working in Queensland in regulated child-related employment for not more than 7 days in a calendar year, you will not require a Queensland issued Working with Children Check (Blue card).
- However, you cannot attend in any role that involves contact with athletes under 18 years of age if you are a **restricted person** under the *Working with Children (Risk Management and Screening) Act 2000*.
